

This is a general guideline for expectations when it comes to playing on the Div. A, B, C (Squirt – Bantam) and Midget teams.

- **Div. A Players:** This division has the highest level of competition. Players must commit to this high level of competition. Players on this team are expected to practice 2-3 times a week. Players are encouraged to attend clinics and strive to excel in the position they are playing. Div. A starts at the Squirt level. Typically participate in at least 2-3 tournaments and in addition teams are expected to attend Provincials (early July) and go on to Westerns (PeeWee and up, early Aug.) if successful.
- **Div. B Players:** This is the developmental stage for players striving to move up and learn the skills of the game while still having a fun experience. Players on this team are expected to practice 1-2 times a week. Still have a strong sense of competitiveness at league games. Typically participate in 1-2 tournaments. It is up to the individual teams if they wish to attend Provincials (early July).
- **Div. C Players:** Designed to work on skill development at more of a recreational level. Each team can decide on the amount of tournaments they wish to participate in or only focus on league play. It is up to the individual teams if they wish to attend Provincials (early July). League play winds down the end of June.
- **Midget A:** Teams play in the Saskatoon Amateur Softball Association. League runs May - Aug. This division has the highest level of competition. Players must commit to this high level of competition. Players on this team are expected to practice 2-3 times a week. Typically participate in at least 2-3 tournaments and in addition teams are expected to attend Provincials (early July) and go on to Westerns (early Aug.) or Nationals (Mid Aug.) if successful.
- **Midget B:** Teams play in the Saskatoon Amateur Softball Association. League runs May - Aug. Players on this team are expected to practice 1-2 times a week. Typically participate in 1-2 tournaments. It is up to the individual teams if they wish to attend Provincials (early July).
- **Midget C:** Teams play in the Saskatoon Amateur Softball Association. League runs May - Aug. Each team can decide on the amount of tournaments they wish to participate in or only focus on league play. It is up to the individual teams if they wish to attend Provincials (early July).
